 One Are Your Child's Im-
 munizations Up to Date?*

If your child is in kindergarten and has not yet received their preschool immunization after the age of four, they are due now. Immunizations provided for the preschool booster consists of the fifth dose of Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, and the second dose of Measles, Mumps, Rubella, and Varicella (chickenpox).

Please bring a copy of your child's Immunization Records and Alberta Health Care Card.

C.P. Blakely staff are planning ahead for the upcoming year.

In mid-August, Chinook's Edge will be sending home your "Annual Re-Enrollment and Consents" for the 2024-2025 year.. The form will need to be completed and submitted prior to the start of the school year.

The form will ensure your registration and certain consents for the upcoming school year.

The form contains a Walking field trip, Technology, and FOIP consents that has to be completed every year before your child can participate in these activities.

We are asking parents and guardians to ensure that they can sign into their PowerSchool parent portal account before the end of the year. If you are having troubles with your username or password, please contact your school before the end of May to get help.
