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## Getting Ready for Grade One

Are your Child's Immunizations Up to Date?

If your child is in kindergarten and has not received their preschool immunization after the age of four, they are due now.

Immunizations provided for the preschool booster consists of the fifth dose of Diptheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio and a second dose of Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine


#### Grade 5
