## Bus Drop Off Zone at C.P. Blakely

The area in front of C.P. Blakely School, south of the crosswalk, is reserved for buses during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 3:45 p.m.

### **THERE IS TO BE NO STOPPING OR PARKING AT THESE TIMES.**

Parent drop off/pick up zones will be north of crosswalk along 43 street and Harrison Drive. Along 43 Street, which runs in front of C.P. Blakely School, there are crosswalks to enable pedestrians to get across the street. It is illegal to park within 5 meters from the approach of a crosswalk.

It is illegal to make a u-turn on a street, unless at the appropriate intersections. The by-law enforcement officers will be monitoring these by-laws also.

**IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS, PLEASE AVOID THE USE OF THE STAFF PARKING LOT AS A PICK UP AND DROP OFF POINT.**
