
We will also be having a bake sale that day as well. Items can be dropped off the day of the sale or earlier if they can be frozen.

Please ensure you have your correct phone number and email so you are notified in the case of an Inclement Weather announcement.

Reasons for yellow days: extreme cold, heavy snowfall, fog, or freezing rain. Classes will be in session and new learning will be introduced. If your child will be at home on a yellow day, please contact CP Blakely Office.

Reasons for red days: The forecast temperature between 7 and 9 am that day, with Windchill, is minus 45 degrees Celsius or colder. Also, a red day may happen when there is a heavy snowfall or a blizzard warning is in effect at that time. Students will receive learning opportunities through google classroom. Parents do not need to contact the school office on a red day.
